View From The Hill (VFTH)

Hello and welcome to DECEMBER 2012 edition of VFTH. There were 62 crimes recorded on Winchmore Hill Ward in November 2012.

Unfortunately the seasonal burglaries are still high. Ourselves, Bowes, Palmers Green and our Tasking Team have been taking part in a burglary initiative, Op. FARRAGH in the last 6 weeks. Week on week the totals have fallen on these three wards. Last month we had 14 residential, 5 attempted and 0 artifices.

Locations for last month were:- Roseneath, no idea on method of entry for this one but laptop taken and vehicle from the driveway. Holly Lodge, entry via rear ground floor window and TV taken. Bourne Hill, again rear ground floor window forced and laptop taken. The communal door and the internal door to a flat forced in Green Lanes and laptop and mobile taken. Person arrested at time of offence to a burglary in Vicars Moor Lane, enquiries ongoing. Front door forced in Fernleigh Road, suspect disturbed and made

Off. Rear ground floor window forced in Branscombe Gdns and a vehicle taken here. Jewellery and electricals taken from a House in Hoppers Rd again rear ground floor entry. Side window forced in Compton Road and electrical items taken. Forensics has identified a suspect to a flat broken into in Hadley Hall. Arrest pending for this one. Again forensics has identified suspects for a break in Vicars Moor Lane. Enquiries ongoing here. Another laptop taken from Orpington Rd, entry again rear ground floor. Please please don't leave your laptops lying on the coffee table on view in your lounge. You maybe inviting the opportunist in. other crimes this month on the ward are 2 non-residential burglaries, 15 motor vehicle crimes, 4 where the vehicle was taken, 3 other thefts;8 assaults; 4 public order offence, 3 criminal damages and 3 drugs offences
