At our last Public consultation this year you told us what concerns you in Winchmore Hill.

You said - Speeding

We have run numerous speed gun operations around the ward.

We have liaised with the council and residents to identify and modify potentially dangerous junctions.

We conducted road safety operations with local primary schools and council road safety unit.

You said - Burglary

We have conducted crime prevention surveys for victims and their neighbours.

We have worked with the local council on alley gating schemes for vulnerable streets.

You said - anti social behaviour on Winchmore Hill Green

We conducted patrols in the area.

We visited licensed premises in the area to enforce licensing laws.

Overall crime is reducing year on year and we are continuing to work with partner agencies to ensure the borough of Enfield is a safe place for the whole community

View from the Hill

Dear all,

Welcome to February's View from the Hill. I am sorry to report that January was a particularly bad month for the ward in respect of Burglary. We had 18 burglaries and 3 attempts. The offences were predominantly against blocks of flats, where multiple victims were involved. There was no obvious pattern as to where the burglaries had or were likely to take place, occurring all over Winchmore Hill and surrounding wards. However the method pointed towards one, or a small group of individuals committing the crimes. Last weekend a male was caught and arrested for a similar offence elsewhere in Enfield. Since this arrest we have not suffered a single burglary on our ward. So it looks like we got our man, unfortunately 21 of our residents had to suffer in the meantime. If you live in flats please speak to your landlord to get good security fitted. Maybe intercoms on exterior doors, and good

sturdy doors on each individual flat or room. A lady in Fox Lane saw two males on the roof opposite her, she called police and two men were detained by officers. So please if you see anything suspicious please call police, we can always do with your help. Don't forget you can contact us if you would like a crime prevention survey carried out at your house.

We had two robberies last month, in Aldermans Hill and Hoppers Road, both occurred during the hours of darkness. There was one attempted robbery on a schoolboy near Winchmore Hill School.

There were 7 thefts from motor vehicles last month, number plates and sat navs making up the majority of things stolen. As mentioned in previous issues, please remove or hide valuables in you car.
