You said Speeding

We have run numerous speed gun operations around the ward.

We have liaised with the council and residents to identify and modify potentially dangerous junctions.

We conducted road safety operations with local primary schools and council road safety unit

You said Burglary

We have conducted crime prevention surveys for victims and their neighbours

We have worked with the local council on alley gating schemes for vulnerable streets

We work with Enfield Council, landlords and other agencies to identify and tackle those areas and individuals responsible for causing anti-social behaviour. There were 53 Crimes recorded on Winchmore Hill Ward in December 2011. There were 7 residential burglaries with 2 attempts. 1 non residential burglary, with no attempts. No artifice burglaries. 2 personal robberies and 3 snatches. I will go into these 5 particular crimes in more detail later, with prevention advice.

Big improvement in the figures for motor vehicle crimes Only 4 thefts from motor vehicle, with 1 attempt and 2 where the vehicle itself was taken and driven away and 2 where damage was caused. As reported in last month's VFTH, looks like Winchmore Hill SN Teams continued work on motor vehicle crime is having the desired effect. There were 6 recorded assaults, 2 drugs, 7 thefts, 3 frauds, 2 Criminal Damage and 2 Theft of Petrol Offences. There was 1 indecent exposure offence, which occurred in Grovelands Park. 1 possession of offensive weapon.

Going back to the previously mentioned personal robberies and snatches, all 5 crimes have similarities.

Location: near Winchmore Hill Green/Train station

Time: Early to late evening (dark).

Victim: Female

Property Taken: Mobile Phone.

Suspect: Black Male a/aged 20yrs in dark clothing

Method: In nearly all cases victim has been talking/texting on their mobile phone coming away from the Station/ The Green area and either had it snatched or threats made to hand it over. Please please have your wits about you. I would advise you to use your mobile in.
