View From The Hill (VFTH)

Hello and welcome to JANUARY 2013 edition of VFTH. There were 43 crimes recorded on Winchmore Hill Ward in December 2012. Last month I mentioned Operation FARRAGH, a local burglary initiative, being run by our ward Inspector, Inspector Reynolds. It is a joint Operation involving Palmers Green, Winchmore Hill, Bowes Wards and our Safer Neighbourhoods Tasking Team. Various tactics employed include plain clothes, high visibility foot patrols and high visibility bicycle patrols. As a result we only had 5 residential burglaries with 0 attempts and 0 artifice. Locations for last months burglaries were:- Ringwood Way. Entry via rear ground floor UPVC patio window being smashed between 1.45pm and 4.45pm. Jewellery and a computer taken. Again daytime and again rear patio door forced to gain entry to a dwelling in St Georges Road, jewellery taken. Victim believes they may have left their rear ground floor door unlocked in Compton Road to allow someone to help

themselves to cash. This crime occurring mid morning. No times for entry via again a rear ground floor UPVC window in Caversham Avenue. Victim also unsure as to what has been taken. Daytime burglary in Radcliffe Road where jewellery taken. Believed rear ground floor door left unlocked. Obvious pattern last month where rear ground floor UPVC doors/windows targeted. Please make sure you lock these doors by pulling up the handle and then locking and removing the keys. Make a note and inform other members of your family where the key is located, just in case the need arises to get out in a hurry. Other crimes this month on the ward are 3 non-residential burglaries, 7 thefts from motor vehicle, 10 other thefts; 3 assaults; 1 public order offence, 5 criminal damages; 3 drugs offences; 3 fraud offences and one each of robbery telecom and public order
