We have worked with the local council on alley gating schemes for vulnerable streets

View from the Hill

There were 66 crimes recorded on Winchmore Hill in April 2011

Seven burglaries dwellings last month with 2 attempts. Early evening a first floor flat was entered in Green Lanes via the rear access stairs, leading to a kitchen window, which was open due to the hot weather. A laptop taken. Again in Green Lanes between 5pm and 9am rear ground floor window forced to gain entry to semi detached currently undergoing renovation. Power tools taken and boiler removed from the wall. House entered in Wades Hill via rear ground floor conservatory door being smashed. Times of offence not known or what property taken. Again no specific times but money and jewellery taken from a property in Bourne Hill having been entered from rear ground floor patio doors being smashed. Two flat burglaries in Station Road, sharing a communal door which was forced in the early evening. Again money and jewellery stolen. Another open window due to the hot weather provided the opportunity to enter a flat in Westlake Close in the early evening. No property taken. 2 attempts: jemmy marks noticed on rear garden door in College Road. Dead bolts did their

job on windows in a flat in Crothall Close, no entry gained. 3 robberies: Schoolboy was relieved of his mobile phone and money in Broadfields Avenue, however recovered by a witness and good Samaritan who chased and recovered the property. Again mobiles taken from two 16yr old victims who were in Grovelands park about 9pm. 27yr old female had her bag snatched in Old Park Road in the early afternoon. 5 vehicles stolen; Green Ford Transit from Burford Gdns; Red Civic from Bourne Hill; Red Proton from Derwent Rd; Yamaha motorcycle from Fords Grove and another Vespa motorcycle from Orpington Road. 14 Theft from Motor Vehicle offences. Examples of property taken, all on show, were; cash, sat navs, sunglasses, power tools, phone chargers, sports hold all etc etc. Please don't leave anything on show. Other crimes last month were 4 offences of criminal damage, 2 non dwelling burglaries, 8 assaults, 11 thefts, 3 thefts of petrol, 1 fraud, 2 indecent exposures, 1 vehicle interference and 2 drugs offences.
