### **View From The Hill (VFTH)**

Hello and welcome to NOVEMBER 2012 edition of VFTH. There were 79 crimes recorded on Winchmore Hill Ward in October 2012. We have had the usual seasonal increase in burglary. Last month we had 12 residential, 2 attempted and 0 artifice. It appears maisonettes are being targeted just after dark till about 11pm. All have a side gate leading to the rear garden. Entry gained either by forcing a rear ground floor window or door. Once inside, easier access to the other maisonette residence. Property taken is in the main either cash, jewellery, mobiles and laptops. Maisonettes have been in Eaton Park Road, Lakeside Road, Farm Road, Meadowcroft, Stonard Road and Grovelands Road. The good news is arrests have been made, with charges and remands in custody. . Other locations last month were Houndsden

Road, and Fox Lane. Both again in the evening, rear ground floor entry with jewellery, cash and mobiles taken. If you live in any of these streets, you may well have had a knock at the door from Police. We have been knocking on 5 doors either side and opposite the burglary venue. We are trying to trace any witnesses, informing residents about the crime and the method, also offering a crime prevention survey to residents. If there is no reply an information leaflet is posted through the door. Other crimes of note this month on the ward are 7 non-residential burglaries, 18 motor vehicle crimes, 1 where the vehicle was taken, 2 thefts of petrol, 12 other thefts; 7 assaults; 3 public order offence 2 personal and 1 commercial robbery, 5 criminal damages, 4 frauds, and 1 dangerous Dog offence.
